

"Pupils who can read are overwhelmingly more likely to succeed at school.

Those who cannot will find themselves at constant disadvantage."

Ask questions and learn independently

Reading for pleasure develops skills across the whole curriculum.

It affects literacy skills, including spelling, grammar & comprehension, & encourages richer vocabulary.

It also helps with numeracy skills and general

knowledge.
